



MUSIC PROGRAMS AT THE LIBRARY

I WANT TO DEVOTE MY COLUMN TO AN EXCITING NEW PARTNERSHIP BEING INTRODUCED THIS YEAR AT THE LIBRARY. THE SAN MATEO PUBLIC LIBRARY AND THE MUSIC AT KOHL MANSION PROGRAM WILL SOON LAUNCH A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT TO HOST MUSIC PROGRAMS IN THE OAK MEETING ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY. The Music at Kohl Mansion program is celebrating its 25th Anniversary Season in hosting concerts in the beautiful Great Hall at the Kohl Mansion (Mercy High School in Burlingame); and through its community education program will collaborate with the Library to showcase outstanding music programs for the enjoyment and enrichment of the community in the Main Library.

The relationship between the Library and Music at Kohl Mansion began in the fall of 2006 when the Library received a Bösendorfer grand piano as a gift that was made possible through the generosity of John W. and Nancy Lee Jalonen, Colton Piano of Burlingame and the San Mateo Public Library Foundation. On November 13, 2006, the piano was formally dedicated with a performance by John Parr, Head of Music Staff at the San Francisco Opera, who performed selections of classical music (Chopin, Schumann, and Schubert) as a sampling of the rich sound that emanates from this fine piano. Mr. Parr's participation was secured through the assistance of Patricia Kristof Moy,

Executive Director of Music at Kohl Mansion.

Also performing at the event were Ron and Maryann Sfarzo who performed their original composition of "San Mateo" a song that celebrates the history and charm of the City of San Mateo.

This unique piano is manufactured by Bösendorfer Klavierfabrik, the oldest continuous piano manufacturer in the world. Its history dates back to 1828 when Ignaz Bösendorfer founded this piano manufacturing business in Vienna. Bösendorfer is known as the "slowest piano builder" in the world. It takes about 62 weeks to produce one grand piano. If the time spent aging the wood is included, the piano can take up to seven years to build.

The donation of the Bösendorfer introduced a wonderful opportunity for the Main Library to be a venue for music programs. Shining examples are the many music recitals that have been held each week in the Main Library since the piano was acquired. Music teachers from throughout the Peninsula have enjoyed the opportunity to schedule recitals showcasing performances by their students. In addition, several music associations such as the Music Teachers Association of California and the San Francisco Friends of Chamber Music have held functions at the Library.

Music at Kohl Mansion scheduled two programs in 2007 that were part of their popular Concerts for All Ages and the Music in Schools outreach. The Cavani String Quartet from Cleveland, Ohio, performed in a special Valentine Day's concert, "Falling in Love with Chamber Music"; and Karen Gottlieb, a harpist with the San Francisco Symphony, and Zach Spellman, a tuba player with the San Francisco Opera Orchestra performed as "Puff & Pluck" to delight a multi-generational audience at the Library.

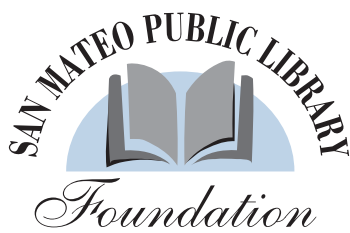

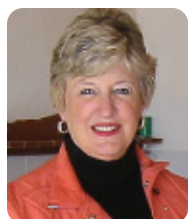
